Introduction

'Strengthening Health Resilience in TB program in Nepal' is the project funded by Global Fund through UNDP Nepal that aims to enhance tuberculosis (TB) prevention, diagnosis, and treatment—especially among high-risk and vulnerable groups in Nepal.

Through evidence-based approaches and leveraging community engagement, the project will address service delivery barriers, boost case detection, expand coverage, improve diagnostics, and support national TB control goals in Nepal. The project period is 1 April 2025 to 31 September 2027.

- Enhance community systems
- Support the National References Laboratories (NRL) and Provincial Laboratories (PHL's)













